

FAQ SHEET

1. Who should attend the Force of Awesome Institute?

a. Anyone doing prevention education, systems change education, and those who train them.

2. Will I be presenting my programs?

a. Yes, please come prepared to present one portion of a presentation you deliver (from 7-10 minutes) repeatedly throughout the Institute. You can choose the presentation you want to use. It can be a presentation that you are having problems with or one that you want to get feedback on from your peers and coaches.

3. What do you mean by coaching?

a. Sharing feedback with your peers, what worked for you and what did not work for you, sharing best practices and tips. The trainers will model this behavior and explain what we are looking for in terms of coaching from other attendees.

4. Does this count towards my certification?

a. Currently we do not have a relationship with NOVA to provide credit to those attending the Institute. However, if you are pursuing something with them or another agency on your own, we are happy to provide material to corroborate your participation in the Institute.

5. What platform is Catharsis Productions using for the Institute?

a. Catharsis Productions uses Zoom for the Institute.

6. What if I must miss a class?

a. We strongly encourage attendees to be present for all the of the sessions as we build from conversations and trainings from previous sessions. We do understand emergencies happen, but we ask that you make the commitment



to be present for each session.

7. Do you offer a non-profit discount?

a. As many of our attendees come from the non-profit or government world, we already price our program assuming this.

8. How much experience do I need to have?

a. We welcome participants from all levels of experience. In fact, we find the collaboration to be strongest when there is a variety of tenure in the room.

9. How many attendees are there?
